REQUEST FOR PUBLIC INPUT

Establishing a Rural Crime Watch Area

The Council for the R.M. of Cana No. 214 is seeking public input on establishing a Rural Crime Watch (RCW) Area :

Purpose

- The main purpose of a RCW Area is to prevent criminal behavior in that area.
- This includes break and enter, thefts or equipment, theft of grains, vandalism, dumping of garbage, cattle rustling, etc.
- To improve the security measures in rural homes, outbuildings, vehicles and machinery.

Organizational Meeting

- To establish a RCW Area a committee must be established to elect a President or Chairperson to ensure organization.
- If necessary, the area would be divided into zones and Zone Coordinators would be appointed.

Membership Application

- A general application would be required to be completed.
- Applicants would be subject to a Criminal Record Check and local indices check at the local RCMP Detachment.

Role of Members

- Report all unusual or suspicious vehicles or occurrence immediately to the RCMP or to 911 for emergencies.
- Respond to RCMP fan-out messages.
- Make an inventory of your property and mark all valuables with your Driver's License Number.
- Display your Rural Crime Watch signs as soon as received.
- Attend any information meetings held in your area and take an active part in your community.
