

BYLAW NO. 4-80

A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINING CONTRACTORS AND
WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Every mining contractor and every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the municipality, and who, in the operation of a mining or well drilling business:
 - (a) contracts to move earth, gravel, stones or mineral of any kind within the municipality; or
 - (b) operates or offers for hire any machine, tractor, truck or appliance used in the process of drilling or of moving earth, gravel, stones or mineral of any kind within the municipality;

shall before undertaking such mining or well-drilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the licence fee prescribed in the following schedule:

For a licence to drill each well for oil, gas or potash	\$300.00
For a licence to drill each structure test hole	\$150.00

2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation.
3. Any contractor holding a licence under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his licence when required to do so by the licence inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
4. Any contractor found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
5. That Bylaw No. 3-53, is hereby repealed.
