

BYLAW NO. 2-93

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL  
AND DESTRUCTION OF BEAVERS WITHIN THE  
RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CANA NO. 214 PURSUANT  
TO SECTION 186 OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. (1) The Council may from time to time, by resolution, provide for the extermination or destruction of beavers, within the municipality, at the expense of the municipality.  
  
(2) Every resolution passed under subsection (1) hereof shall designate the waterway or creek by commonly known name or leagl land description which it relates to.
2. Any agent or servant of the municipality appointed by the council to carry out the provisions of Section 1 hereof shall have the power, for that purpose to enter upon the waterway or creek involved.
3. Any person who obstructs or interferes with any agent or servant while engaged in carryung out provisions of Section 1 hereof shall be liable to summary conviction to the penalty prescribed by Section 413 of the Rural Municipality Act 1989.
