




A BYLAW TO RECOVER FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as "The Fire Services Costs Bylaw".
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the Municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the Municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214.
3. The costs of fire prevention, suppression and/or emergency response services shall be charged in accordance with the rates and procedures contained within the municipal fire protection agreement with the City of Melville, which may be revised from time to time.
4. Upon fire protection, suppression and/or emergency response services being provided on a parcel of land within the Municipality's boundaries, the Municipality may, in its sole and absolute discretion, invoice the costs referenced in Section 3 to any or all of the following persons, namely:
 - a) the person or persons who receive the services; and/or
 - b) the owner or occupant of the land.
5. Ninety (90) days after the person or persons have been invoiced in accordance with Section 3 of this bylaw, the following shall apply:
 - a) a penalty of 10% of the amount outstanding shall be added to and form part of said invoice; and
 - b) the Council authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person or persons invoiced in accordance with Section 4 the total amount outstanding of said invoice, including any penalty added pursuant to Subsection 5.a) of this bylaw.
6. Bylaw No. 14/2019 is hereby repealed.
