

Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214

Bylaw No. 03/2024

A Bylaw to Manage Vehicle Weights

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Cana No. 214 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1) Purpose

- 1) The purposes of this bylaw are:
 - a) to establish and adopt a vehicle weight management system to regulate the weight of vehicles, or vehicles with their loads, using municipal highways or any particular municipal highways in the municipality; and
 - b) to designate routes within the municipality that any vehicle or class of vehicles is required to use when being driven in the municipality.

2) Definitions

- 1) Except as hereinafter provided, words used in the bylaw shall have the meanings ascribed to them in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.
- 2) In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" means the administrator of the municipality, appointed pursuant to section 110 of *The Municipalities Act*.
 - b) "Minister" means the member of the Executive Council to whom for the time being the administration of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, is assigned.

3) Weight Limits on Certain Roads

- 1) No person shall, without a permit issued by the Minister pursuant to section 36 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* operate or move or cause to be operated or moved, on or over a municipal highway a vehicle, the gross vehicle weight of which exceeds the limits set out in section 3.2 and 3.3 of this bylaw.
- 2) The following municipal roads that are built to primary weight standard and indicated on Appendix "A" shall be set at primary weights as set out in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*:
 - a) Range Road 2062 from Highway #15 South to Township Road 220.
 - b) Township Road 232 from Highway #10 East approximately 300 meters to G3 Elevator Approach.
 - c) Township Road 230 from Highway #9 East to Range Road 2040.
 - d) Township Road 232 from Highway #9 West to Range Road 2042.
- 3) All other municipal roads shall be set as secondary weights as set out in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimensions Regulations, 2010*.

4) Permit Fees

- 1) \$50 per single trip with the exception of spring road ban season;
- 2) \$100 per single trip during spring road ban season; and
- 3) \$300.00 for an annual permit.


5) Penalty


- 1) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.
- 2) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

6) Repeal

- 1) That Bylaw No. 10/2019 and Bylaw No. 13/2019 are hereby repealed.




 Primary Weight Roads
